



Preparation for Learning:

Student

- Be prepared and dressed for learning each day and have supplies, work and assignments ready.
- Become familiar with the structure of Google Classroom and how your teacher organizes information.
- Check and maintain your school email daily.

Parent

- Access parent resources to learn how students will navigate Google Classroom.
- Create a designated place in your home for your student to use as their remote classroom.
- (in class instruction): Encourage your child to have their things in their backpack/device and ready for school the night before.

Teacher

- Meet weekly with your content team to plan instruction for all students.
- Utilize your YAG and curriculum documents.
- Full curriculum delivered but can be streamlined or compacted .
- Use the Remote Learning Design as a guide to plan units with the end in mind.

Learning and Teacher Expectations:

Student

- Attend classes according to school schedule (either face to face or remotely) and give your best effort in your school assignments.
- Participate in learning activities face to face or virtual sessions as instructed by teachers.

- Be organized in your work and in getting projects completed.
- Ask questions and communicate with your teachers.
- Be aware of what you should be learning each day.
- Have assignments completed and ready.
- Complete coursework by due date/deadline set by teachers
- **Turn in assignments on time.**

Parents

- Access Parent Portal to view student grades frequently.
- Check in with student(s) to monitor completion of homework and assignments.
- Discuss your child's favorite part of the day and what they learned in school.
- Provide your child with assistance on their day to day activities with the exception of designated independent work.
- Maintain communication with your child's teacher by phone, email and/or online meetings to create a learning partnership.
- Monitor and ask your child for evidence that he/she is on track with assignments and coursework on a weekly basis.

Teacher

- Teach students how to access training materials through Google Classroom.
- Provide instruction and facilitate learning throughout the day.(different classes)
- Weekly schedule posted in the Google Classroom prior to 8:00am on Monday for that week.
- Provide clear learning goals for students.
- All instructional support and guidelines will be in Google Classroom.
- Follow the expectations established across the district for Google Classroom.(3rd-8th grades)
- Follow local grading policies(prior to Spring) and be consistent with on-campus grading.
- Post grades in a timely manner according to the campus grading guidelines. (3 grades every two weeks)
